## Goal of Community Trends

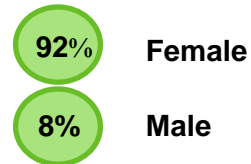
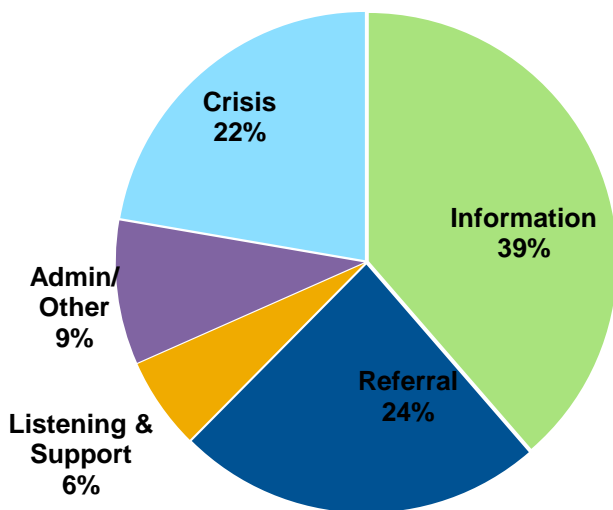

**Types of contacts**

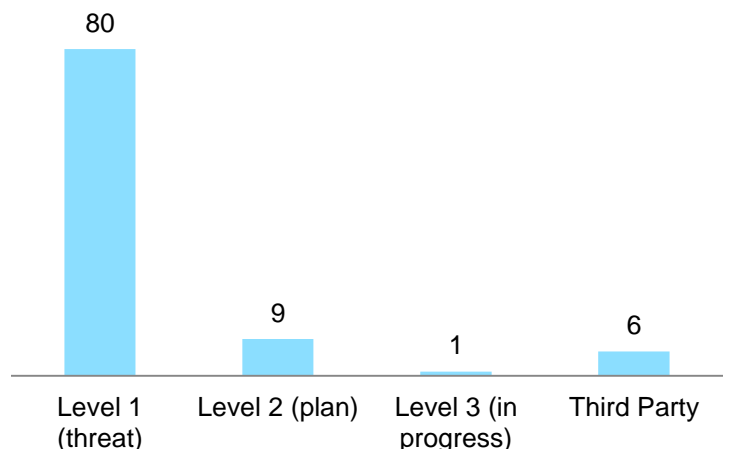
