

1. Christmas Basket Interviews:

The Salvation Army provides food baskets to needy families and individuals for their Christmas meal. Volunteers are needed to record the financial and personal information of those in need. The Salvation Army staff then takes the information that is collected to determine if they are eligible to received the food baskets.

A short volunteer training session will be held at 6pm on Monday, November 23rd at The Salvation Army.

2. Senior Food Commodity Boxes:

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSPF) is a USDA food assistance program provided to eligible senior citizens through the Salvation Army and the Food Service Center. Once a month low-income seniors receive a supplemental food box. The boxes are either delivered to the seniors homes or are picked up by the senior at The Salvation Army.

10 Volunteers needed for each shift (5 home delivery with Salvation Army Staff & 5 facility) Thursday, December 10th - 10am – noon and 1pm to 4pm

3. Toy Town & Christmas Basket Distribution Days:

The distribution of the food baskets for families and individuals and toys for families will be held the week of Christmas. Volunteers are needed to help carry the food and toys to the recipient's vehicles.

Monday, December 21st – 6pm – 8:30pm Tuesday, December 22nd – 9am -11:30am, 1pm – 4pm

4. Food Donations:

Volunteers are needed to collect and donate food to help fill the food baskets and the food pantry that is located inside The Salvation Army. Food donations will be accepted through Friday, December 18th.
